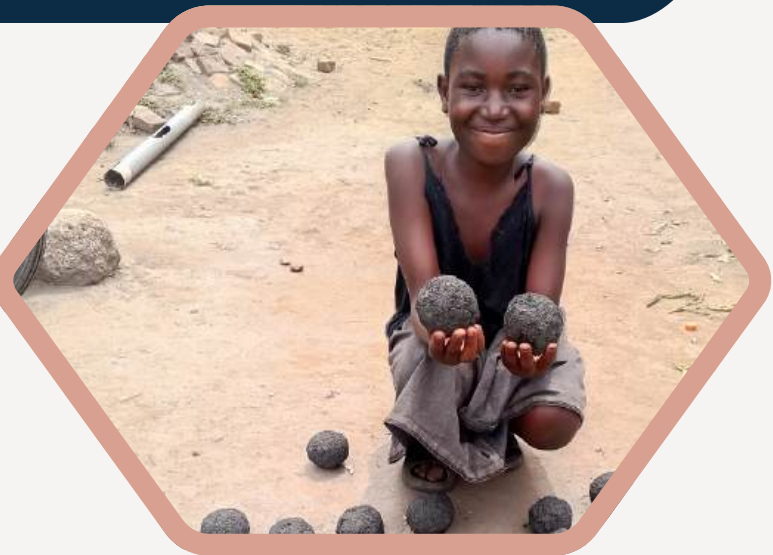

KABUGHO SARA (BENEFICIARY)

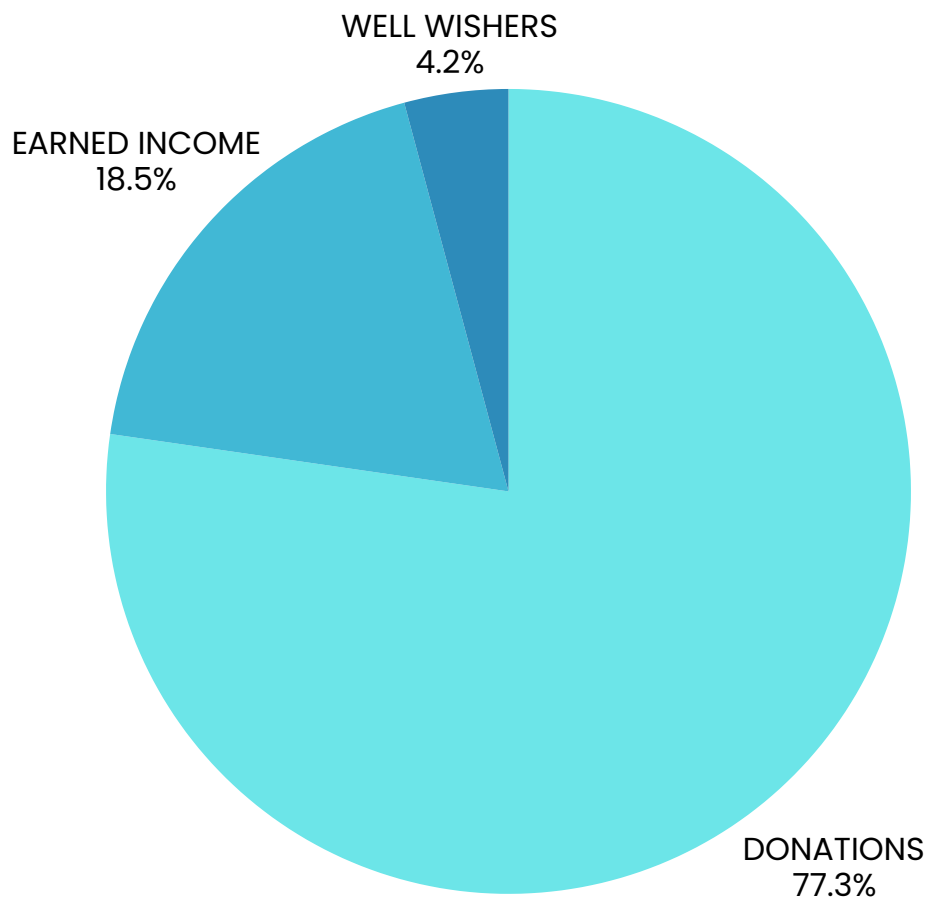
Before joining kickstart foundation Uganda's livelihood program, Sarah struggled to earn a stable income after flood damaged her crops. In 2024, she was selected for a training in mushroom growing and spawn multiplication using the available locally materials.

Within a few months Sarah began producing mushroom for home consumption and sales in the local market, the income has helped her improve household income, pay school fees for her child and reduce dependence on her male sponsor. This business has provided her with reliable, climate resilient livelihoods that requires little land and water.

Today Sarah is confident, food secure and actively training other young mothers to also do the same. Her story highlights how kickstart Foundation Uganda enabling vulnerable households and individuals to build a sustainable and resilient livelihoods.

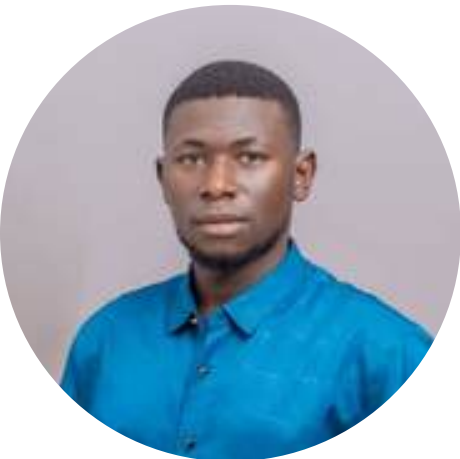
